We divided into two groups:

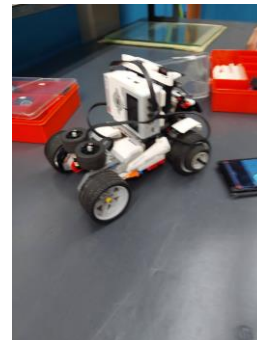
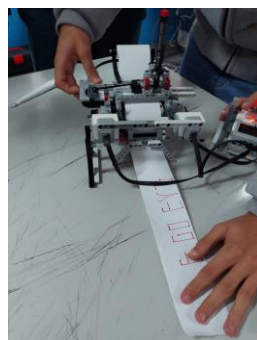
Group one visited Centro Escolar de Joane – Preschool and First Cycle of Basic Education and had job shadowing on STEAM approach in early childhood, PEBI – the Bilingual Schools Programme, DAC – Cross-Curricular Articulation



Group two focused on vocational education in upper secondary levels: visit to school facilities, focus on resources and teaching/ learning approaches (health care, civil protection, programming equipment, design managing and programming, information, systems multimedia, mechatronics, electronics, automation and computers).

After a break school managers and teachers took part to labs dedicated to **Science teaching and learning** (cooperation strategies for school success, class observation and discussion 12th grade) and to **Inclusive Education** (visit to premises, focus on approaches and inclusive activities) and **Adapted sports**.

Students took part to an **English teaching and learning** activity (cooperation strategies for school success, class observation and discussion 10th grade)

Day 4 (11th November)

Topic: Cooperation for success - Discussion and activities in three group

Group 1 School managers

Cooperated with Famalicao local stakeholders, discussing about innovation, entrepreneurship, and internationalization – The role of education, municipality, and local industry

Group 2 Teachers

Focused on projects and the cooperative approach and had presentations and group discussion



Group 3 Students

Focused on planning, studying, learning, sharing through group discussion, presentation and cooperation games

After that we talked about project management.

The activities finished with the closure and delivery of certificates
